At Dynasty DBA Access Pro (“Access Pro” or “we”), we know how important it is to feel that your personal information is handled with care online. We are committed to maintaining the trust and confidence of all visitors to our website, including www.access-pros.net and any related pages or subdomains (the “Site”), as well as individuals and businesses who contact us, engage with our services, attend our events, apply for opportunities, or otherwise interact with us online or offline.

This Privacy Policy applies to information collected from visitors to our Site, including all related pages or subdomains, and from individuals and businesses who communicate with us through forms, email, phone, social media, conferences, trade shows, recruiting efforts, and other business channels. It also applies to customers, prospects, vendors, applicants, contractors, partners, and other business contacts who engage with Access Pro.

Categories of Personal Information Processed by Access Pro and Purposes for Processing

Access Pro may collect the following categories of personal information:

Name

Email address

Phone number

Company name

Job title

Business address or mailing address

Billing information when applicable

Information submitted through forms, surveys, event registrations, emails, job applications, or other messages

Information about your interest in our services, solutions, events, or opportunities

Records of communications with our team

Website usage data such as IP address, browser type, device information, pages visited, referring website information, and general analytics data

Access Pro may collect, use, or share personal information where it is reasonably necessary to communicate with website visitors, customers, and business contacts; answer questions; provide services and support; process transactions; manage billing; send requested information; support recruiting and onboarding activities; coordinate meetings, demos, and events; improve our website and business operations; maintain security; and comply with legal, tax, accounting, or regulatory obligations.

If you fill out a form on our Site to request information, schedule a conversation, apply for a role, respond to a promotion, or indicate interest in our services, we may contact you to provide the information you requested and to share additional relevant information about Access Pro and our services. You may unsubscribe from non-essential marketing emails at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link in one of our emails or by contacting us at contact@access-pros.net.

When you contact an Access Pro team member at a conference, trade show, networking event, or online, we may collect your name, email address, phone number, company name, and related business information so we can respond to your request, continue the conversation, or send follow-up information relevant to your interests.

When you submit billing or payment information to pay an invoice or purchase a service, that information may be collected and processed by our payment or accounting partners rather than stored directly by Access Pro.

Who Else Has Access to Personal Information

We do not sell or rent your personal information to other companies or businesses for direct marketing purposes.

We do use third-party service providers to support different parts of our website, communications, customer management, recruiting, onboarding, sales operations, training, invoicing, analytics, and marketing. These service providers may have access to personal information only as needed to perform services on our behalf and are expected to use it only for authorized business purposes.

Depending on the nature of your interaction with Access Pro, support personnel, administrative staff, sales personnel, marketing personnel, recruiting personnel, leadership, or operations staff who need the information to perform their responsibilities may have access to your personal information.

If you contact us as a customer, prospect, vendor, applicant, contractor, or other business contact, only the team members who reasonably need access to that information to respond, support, process, or manage the relationship should have access to it.

Other Ways We May Use Personal Information

We may disclose personal information when necessary to comply with applicable law, legal process, court orders, subpoenas, or governmental requests, or when needed to establish, exercise, or defend our legal rights.

We may also disclose personal information when we believe it is appropriate to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding suspected fraud, illegal activity, violations of our website terms or business policies, threats to the safety of any person, or other situations where disclosure is permitted or required by law.

From time to time, Access Pro may offer promotions, contests, giveaways, surveys, or other marketing initiatives. If you choose to participate, we may collect information such as your name, email address, phone number, or other details needed to administer the

promotion, communicate with you, and deliver any related updates or prizes. We may also use limited aggregated or de-identified information from those activities to better understand interest in our services, events, or offerings.

We may disclose or transfer personal information in connection with a proposed or completed merger, acquisition, financing, restructuring, sale of assets, or other business transition. In those circumstances, we will take reasonable steps to ensure the information remains protected and is used in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Newsletter Sign-Up and Marketing Communications

If you sign up to receive updates, news, hiring information, event notices, or other marketing communications from Access Pro, we will collect your contact information so we can send those communications to you.

We may use marketing emails to share updates about our services, events, team announcements, hiring opportunities, promotions, case studies, articles, or other business-related information. We may also contact you from time to time to confirm that our records are accurate and up to date.

When we send email communications, we may use standard tools that help us understand overall engagement, such as whether emails were opened or whether links were clicked. We use this information in an aggregate way to improve our communications and better understand what information is useful to our audience.

You can unsubscribe from marketing emails at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link in the email or by contacting us at contact@access-pros.net. We may still send service-related, transactional, or operational communications when necessary.

We do not rent, sell, or trade email lists with other organizations or businesses for their direct marketing use.

Third-Party Tools and Service Providers

We select providers we believe are appropriate for business use and expect them to process information only for legitimate business purposes related to the services they perform for us.

Data Security

Access Pro uses reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to help protect personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, misuse, alteration, or destruction. No system can guarantee complete security, but we take data privacy and security seriously and work to use commercially reasonable measures to protect the information we handle.

Where appropriate, we use secure platforms, password controls, access restrictions, and security practices designed to limit access to personal information to those who need it for legitimate business purposes. We also rely on reputable third-party providers to help support secure communications, storage, and processing.

Our team members are expected to follow internal practices regarding appropriate data handling and access. Access to personal information is generally limited to individuals who need it to perform a specific business function.

Cookies and Internet Tracking Technologies

When someone visits the Access Pro Site, we or our service providers may collect standard internet log information and details about visitor behavior patterns. We use this information to understand website traffic, page usage, general visitor engagement, and opportunities to improve the Site and our communications.

Like many websites, the Access Pro Site may use cookies, pixels, session tools, analytics tools, and similar technologies. These technologies help the Site function properly, support navigation, remember preferences, understand how visitors use the Site, and improve performance over time.

Social Media Sites

As with any public-facing social media platform, information you post on social media, in public comments, or in public forums may be visible to others. If you interact with Access Pro through LinkedIn, Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, or other platforms, any information you choose to share there may be collected and used by others who can view that content.

In some cases, we may not be able to remove the content ourselves, depending on the platform or how the content was posted, but we will let you know if that is the case.

Your Privacy Rights
